



Food Safety Industry Council

Authority: A.R.S §11-251 (general powers) and by the direction of the Board of Supervisors as outlined in Resolution No. 2166.

Membership: Thirteen members, two from each Supervisor District, all of whom represent the food industry, and three at-large members representing consumer members. Representatives from the University of Arizona Cooperative Extension Service and the Environmental Health Division of the Yavapai County Community Health Services Department serve as ex officio members.

Term of office: One member from each Supervisor District, representing the food industry, shall serve a two-year term, and one member from each Supervisor District, representing the food industry, shall serve a three-year term. Members at-large representing the consumer members shall serve for three years, with staggered terms.

General Duties: Advises the University of Arizona Cooperative Extension Service and the Environmental Decision of the Yavapai County Community Health Services Department regarding food safety issues in the County.
