Authority: Workforce Investment Act of 1998, Public Law 105-220, Sec. 117, Yavapai County Resolution Nos. 1642, 1826, and 1921 (supersedes 1642 and 1826)

Membership: The Executive Committee will consist of five private-sector members, one from each Supervisorial District in which they reside or conduct business, plus one non-voting public representative from the operating entity.

Term of Office: two years, staggered

General Duties: Involving the private business sector in delivering workforce investment services. Build economic success through workforce development partnerships and, in collaboration with the Board of Supervisors, provide guidance and oversight of activities under the Workforce Investment Plan for Yavapai County.

Meets: Bi-monthly, odd number of months
