- 1. Approve minutes of meeting of October 5, 1998.
- 2. Consider approval of items appearing on the Consent Agenda and on the Consent Agenda for Special Districts.
- ITEM NO. 2. 8:55 a.m. Resolve into Board of Directors of Yavapai County Flood Control District.
- 1. Approve minutes of meeting of September 21, 1998.
