The above matter having come on regularly for final hearing, in accordance with law, and the petition for the establishment of a highway for Yavapai County, as hereinafter described, having been fully considered, and all opposition, objections, demands and claims for compensation, and all evidence relevant thereto, having been heard, and

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that said petition for the establishment of said highway should be granted, and the establishment of said highway ordered, and said being the judgment of this Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, that the petition for the establishment of the highway as hereinafter described be granted, and that said highway be established, and that this resolution be recorded in the Minutes of this Board,

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that all lands, estate, interest, or thing described as prayed for in said petition, be, and the same are hereby condemned and appropriated to public use.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an award be, and the same is hereby made unto Oscar F. Irwin and Hilah Irwin, his wife, claimants herein, in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), as full compensation for property taken hereunder, and as payment for all damages accruing to said claimants by reason of these proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an award be, and the same is hereby made unto Bernard C. Black, claimant herein, in the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), as compensation for property taken and as payment in full of all damages accruing to said claimant by reason of these proceedings.

Said highway, which is hereby ordered established, has a beginning, a terminus, and a general course and direction, as follows:

Beginning on State Highway 79 in Section 1, Township 15 North of Range 3 East, running thence in an easterly direction 4.6 miles more or less to Cornville; thence in an easterly direction 1 mile to the junction of the road to Page Springs; thence in an easterly direction 1 mile more or less; thence in a southeasterly direction 7.6 miles more or less to a junction with the Camp Verde - Stoneman's Lake Road; and

said highway is more particularly described on a map of the said highway, which map has been filed herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this judgment, together with the said map of the said highway, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said County being the County wherein the said highway is located.
