The above matter having come on regularly for hearing in accordance with law and the petition for the establishment of a highway in Yavapai County, as hereinafter described, having been fully considered, and all opposition, objections, demands and claims for compensation, and all evidence relevant thereto having been heard, and

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that said petition for the establishment of said highway should be granted, and the establishment of said highway ordered, and the same being the judgment of this Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, that the petition for the establishment of the highway as hereinafter described be granted, and that said highway be established, and that this resolution be recorded in the Minutes of this Board as of this date.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that all lands, estate, interest or thing described as prayed for in said petition be and the same are hereby condemned and appropriated to public use.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following awards be and the same are hereby made unto the following persons as full compensation for property taken hereunder and as payment for all damages accruing to said persons by reason of these proceedings.

Said highway which is hereby ordered established is described as follows with reference to its beginning, terminus and general course of direction :

Beginning at Engineer's Station 583 x 64.06, the end of the present Federal Aid Construction on the Bridgeport-Montezuma Castle Highway; running thence in a general Southerly direction through Section 33, Township 15 North, Range 5 East and Sections 3, 4, 5, 8, 17, 18 and 19, Township 14 North, Range 5 East, 6.1 miles, more or less, to a point on the present road to Camp Verde, including also the Wye connection for the road to Stoneman Lake.

Said highway is more particularly described on the map of said highway, which map has been filed herein and is annexed hereto.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this judgment, together with the said map of said highway, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said County being the County wherein the said highway is located.
