The above matter having come on regularly for hearing in accordance with law and the petition for the abandonment of a portion of a highway in Yavapai County, Arizona, as hereinafter described, having been fully considered and all opposition, objections, demands and claims for compensation, and all evidence relevant thereto having been heard, and

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that said petition for the abandonment of portions of said highway should be granted, and the same being the judgment of this Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, that the petition for abandonment of portions of the highway, as hereinafter described, be granted and that this resolution be recorded in the Minutes of said Board as of this date;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all portions of said highway herein abandoned shall revert to and vest severally in the owners of the bounding and abutting property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no compensation be paid to any person by reason of this action by said Board of Supervisors.

The portion of said highway which is hereby abandoned is described as follows with reference to its beginning, terminus and general course of direction:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Block E, Joslin-Whipple Subdivision; thence northerly along the west line of Block E and the west line of Block 8, Moeller Addition, to the northwest corner of said Block 8; thence westerly along the south line of Moeller Street produced, 40 feet to a point; thence southerly, parallel to the west line of Block 8, 150 feet to a point 40 feet westerly from the southwest corner of Lot 8, Block 8; thence southeasterly 104.73 feet to a point 20 feet westerly from the south corner of Lot 6, Block 8; thence southerly, parallel to the west line of Block E, Joslin-Whipple Subdivision, 246.65 feet to a point on the north line of Sheldon Street produced, 20 feet westerly from the southwest corner of said Block E; thence easterly 20 feet to the place of beginning.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this resolution, together with a map of said highway, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said county being the county wherein the said highway is located.
