RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF AN ALLEY

The above matter having come on regularly for hearing in accordance with law and the petition for the abandonment of a portion of an alley in Yavapai County, Arizona, as hereinafter described, having been fully considered and all opposition, objections, demands and claims for compensation, and all evidence relevant thereto having been heard, and

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that said petition for the abandonment of a portion of said alley should be granted, and the same being the judgment of this Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, that the petition for abandonment of a portion of the alley, as hereinafter described, be granted and that this resolution be recorded in the Minutes of said Board as of this date;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all portions of said alley herein abandoned shall revert to and vest severally in the owners of the bounding and abutting property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no compensation be paid to any person by reason of this action by said Board of Supervisors.

The portion of said alley which is hereby abandoned is described as follows:

Between Lots 12, 24 and 25, and between the south fifteen (15) feet of Lots 11 and 23, Block 4, Hopkins Ranch Subdivision No. 2, Cottonwood, Yavapai County, Arizona, according to the official map or plat thereof on file in the office of the County Recorder of said County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this resolution, together with a map of said Block 4, Hopkins Ranch Subdivision No. 2, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said County being the County wherein the said alley is located.
