The above matter having come on regularly for hearing in accordance with law and the petition for the abandonment of a portion of Navajo Road in Yavapai County, Arizona, as hereinafter described, and no persons appearing in opposition thereto and having been fully considered and all evidence relevant thereto having been heard, and

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that said petition for the abandonment of a portion of Navajo Road should be granted, and the same being the judgment of this Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, that the petition for abandonment of a portion of Navajo Road, as hereinafter described, be granted and that this resolution be recorded in the Minutes of said Board as of this this date;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all portions of said Navajo Road herein abandoned shall revert to and vest severally in the owners of the bounding and abutting property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no compensation be paid to any person by reason of this action by said Board of Supervisors.

The portion of said Navajo Road which is hereby abandoned is described as follows, with reference to its beginning, terminus and general course of direction:

Beginning at a line running from the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block F, to the most northerly corner of Lot 1, Block E, thence along and between Lots 1 and 4 of said Block F and Lots 1, 2 and 3 of said Block E to a line running from the Southwest corner of Lot 4, Block F to the Southeast corner of Lot 3, Block E, all in Plat F of Hassayampa Mountain Club, Yavapai County, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this resolution, together with a map of said highway, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said county being the county wherein said Navajo Road is located.
