The above matter having come on regularly for hearing on the 6th day of March, 1950, having been set for said date by the Board of Supervisors, and there being no opposition, objections, demands and no claims for compensation and no evidence having been submitted at said hearing and the Board of Supervisors having easements to all of said right-of-way and no transcript having been taken at said hearing for the reason no evidence was submitted; and

IT APPEARING TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that said petition for the establishment and altering of said highway as set forth in said petition should be granted and an order establishing, altering and designating said highway be entered herein, and that being the judgment of this Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the petition for the establishment and alteration of Page Springs Road, as hereinafter described, be granted and that said road be altered, designated and established as a public highway and that this resolution be recorded in the minutes of this Board as of this date;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all property, easements, and all interests therein, as described and set forth in

said petition, or which may be necessary for the purpose of the completion of said highway, be, and the same are, hereby condemned and appropriated to public use;

The said highway which is hereby ordered altered, designated and established is described as follows with reference to its beginning, terminus, and general course of direction:

Beginning at a point in the Cornville-McGuireville-Camp Verde Highway, approximately one mile east of Cornville; thence northerly, east of Oak Creek; approximately 4.8 miles to the bridge across Oak Creek; the county road to follow the present alignment, except in places where curves can be eliminated or improved.

the exact boundaries on both sides of said highway being more particularly described on the map thereof in the office of the County Engineer of Yavapai County, Arizona, a copy of which map will be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, and reference is hereby made to said map for a more particular description of said highway.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this judgment, together with the said map above referred to of said highway, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said County being the County wherein the said highway is located.
