The above matter having come on first to be heard on the 1st day of February, 1954, and having been set for final hearing on the 15th day of March, 1954, and there being no opposition, objections, demands, and no claim for compensation, and no evidence having been submitted at said hearings, and the Board of Supervisors having information that the right of way for said Mason Avenue is dedicated to the public for its general use by the plat of record in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, and no transcript having been made of said hearing for the reason no evidence was submitted; and there being no private property affected on said Mason Avenue, no board of appraisers were appointed; and

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that the designating and establishing of Mason Avenue, as set forth in said petition, is a public necessity and said petition should be granted, and an order designating and establishing said street be entered herein, and that being the judgment of this Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the petition for the designation and establishment of Mason Avenue be granted, and that said street be designated and established as a public highway, and that this resolution be recorded in the minutes of this Board as of this date; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all property, easements, and all interests therein, as described and set forth in said petition,

or which may be necessary for the purpose of the completion of said road, be, and the same are, hereby condemned and appropriated to public use.

The said road which is hereby designated and established is described as follows:

Beginning on the west line of Mingus Street and extending east to the east line of Third Street, a distance of 834 feet.

The exact boundaries on both sides of said road being more particularly described on the map thereof in the office of the County Engineer of Yavapai County, Arizona, a copy of which map will be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, and reference is hereby made to said map for a more particular description of said road.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this judgment, together with the said map above referred to of said road, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said county being the county wherein the said highway or road is located.
