The above matter having come on first to be heard on the 22nd day of October, 1956, and having been set for final hearing on December 3, 1956, and all matters there presented having been duly heard by the Board of Supervisors, and said Board having fully considered all evidence relevant thereto, and,

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that the designating and establishing of Sheepshead Crossing as set forth in said petition, as a County Road, is a public necessity and said petition should be granted, and an order designating and establishing said road be entered herein; and,

It appearing to said Board of Supervisors that the Report of the Appraisers heretofore appointed in this matter is on file herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the petition for the designating and establishing of Sheepshead Crossing as a County Road, as hereinafter described, be granted, and that said road be designated and established as a public highway and that this resolution be recorded in the minutes of this Board as of this date, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all property, easements, and all interests therein, as described and set forth in said petition, or which may be necessary for the purpose of the completion of said highway, be, and the same are hereby condemned and appropriated to public use; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following awards, be, and the same are hereby made unto the following persons as full compensation for all property taken hereunder and as full payment for all damages accruing to said persons by reason of these proceedings:

The said highway which is hereby ordered designated and established is described as follows with reference to its beginning, terminus and general course of direction:

A Right of Way, 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of a center line described as follows:

Beginning at Engineer's station 0+00, a point on the north Right of Way line of the Bridgeport-Cornville county highway, from which point the southeast corner of Section 4, Township 15 North, Range 4 East, bears S. 79° 32' E., 326.84 feet distant;

Thence N. 2° 05' W., 630.97 feet to Station 6+30.97;

Thence N. 6° 54' W., 641.60 feet to Station 12+72.57;

Thence N. 14° 27' W., 561.20 feet to a P.C. Station 18+33.77;

Thence on a 4° curve to the left, 612.5 feet to P. T. Station 24+46.27;

Thence N. 38° 57' W., 778.73 feet to Station 32+25;

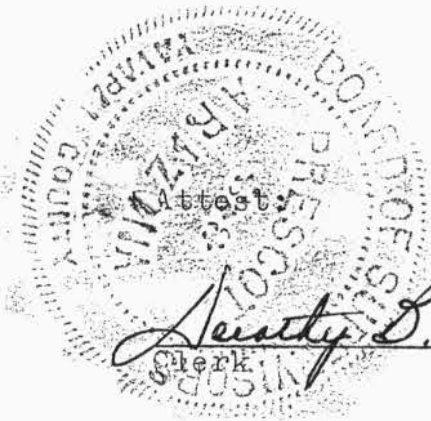
This Right of Way is a part of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 4, Township 15 North, Range 4 East.

The exact boundaries on both sides of said highway being more particularly described on the map thereof in the office of the County Engineer of Yavapai County, Arizona, a copy of which map will be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, and reference is hereby made to said map for a more particular description of said highway.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this judgment, together with the said map above referred to of said highway, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, said county being the county wherein the said highway is located.
