RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

The above matter having come on regularly for hearing in accordance with law and the petition for the abandonment of a portion of right of way lying outside the present right of way lines of State Highway 89, and being a part of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter, Section 9, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, as hereinafter described, and no persons appearing in opposition thereto, and the matter having been fully considered and all evidence relevant thereto having been heard, and

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that said petition for the abandonment of a portion of right of way lying outside the present right of way lines of State Highway 89, and being a part of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter, Section 9, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, should be granted and the same being the judgment of this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, that the petition for abandonment of a portion of right of way lying outside the present right of way lines of State Highway 89, and being a part of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter, Section 9, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, as hereinafter described, be granted and that this resolution be recorded in the Minutes of said Board as of this date, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a portion of right of way lying outside the present right of way lines of State Highway 89, and being a part of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter, Section 9, Township 13

North, Range 2 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, shall revert to and vest in the owners of the bounding and abutting property; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no compensation be paid to any person by reason of this action by said Board of Supervisors. The said portion which is hereby abandoned is described as follows, with reference to its beginning, terminus and general course of direction:

That part of the following described tract of land that lies outside of the present right of way line of State Highway No. 89:

A strip of land thirty feet on each side of a center line described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Prescott-White Spar Highway which point is known as Engineer's Station No. 77x11 and from which point the S. W. Corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, T 13 N, R 2 W, bears due west a distance of 1097.0 feet; thence from this point N. $30^{\circ} 31\frac{1}{2}'$ E., a distance of 138.2 feet; thence through a $24^{\circ} 12'$ curve to the left for a distance of 85.1 feet; thence through a 6° curve to the left for a distance of 343.7 feet; thence through a $26^{\circ} 36'$ curve to the left for a distance of 175.9 feet; thence N. $74^{\circ} 44\frac{1}{2}'$ W., a distance of 51.6 feet; thence through a $5^{\circ} 50'$ curve to the right for a distance of 244.4 feet; thence through a $25^{\circ} 51'$ curve to the right for a distance of 152.2 feet; thence through a $32^{\circ} 44'$ curve to the right for a distance of 125.5 feet; thence N. $5^{\circ} 27\frac{1}{2}'$ E., for a distance of 131.3 feet; thence through a $24^{\circ} 55'$ curve to the right for a distance of 147.4 feet; thence N. $39^{\circ} 14\frac{1}{2}'$ E., for a distance of 113.2 feet; thence through a $28^{\circ} 39'$ curve to the left for a distance of 193.1 feet; thence N. $16^{\circ} 05'$ W., for a distance of 1015.3 feet; thence through a curve to a $9^{\circ} 56'$ curve to the right for a distance of 402.8 feet; thence $7^{\circ} 10'$ curve to the right for a distance of 196.2 feet; thence through a $28^{\circ} 39'$ curve to the left for a distance of 159.8 feet; thence N. $7^{\circ} 49\frac{1}{2}'$ W., for a distance of 55.1 feet; thence through a $20^{\circ} 30'$ curve to the right for a distance of 227.2 feet; thence N. $38^{\circ} 39\frac{1}{2}'$ E., for a distance of 156.9 feet; thence a $28^{\circ} 39'$ curve to the left for a distance 192.8 feet; thence N. $16^{\circ} 34\frac{1}{2}'$ W., for a distance of 65.2 feet; thence through a $16^{\circ} 49'$ curve to the right for a distance of 283.0 feet more or less to a point on the Section line between Sections Nine and Four, T 13 N, R 2 W, Gila and Salt River Meridian.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this resolution, together with a map of said portion of right of way, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said county being the county wherein said portion of right of way is located.
