

RESOLUTION

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WHEREAS, Yavapai County would lose more than \$168,000 annually in taxes if the Federal Government builds the electric transmission lines from Glen Canyon Dam throughout Arizona; and,

WHEREAS, this all-Federal system would deprive Arizona state and local governments and school districts of \$750,000 in needed tax revenues; and,

WHEREAS, the Nation's taxpayers would save over \$60 Million by using Arizona Public Service Company lines; and,

WHEREAS, under its plan, Arizona Public Service Company can build these lines cheaper, provide better service, save taxpayers' money while at the same time making sizable tax payments, and still earn a fair return on its investment; and,

WHEREAS, adoption of the Combination proposal would help prevent the further spread of socialized power in the United States,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, hereby respectfully request that the Secretary of the Interior, and the Arizona Congressional Delegation favorably consider adoption of the Combination "Federal Government--Investor-Owned Utility Company's" proposal to build the Colorado River Storage Project transmission system.
