RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

The above matter having come on regularly for hearing in accordance with law and the petition for the abandonment of a certain 20' Roadway, Yavapai County, Arizona, as hereinafter described, and no persons appearing in opposition thereto, and the matter having been fully considered and all evidence relevant thereto having been heard, and

It appearing to the Board of Supervisors that said petition for the abandonment of a certain 20' Roadway, should be granted and the same being the judgment of this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, that the petition for abandonment of a certain 20' Roadway, as hereinafter described, be granted and that this resolution be recorded in the Minutes of said Board as of this date, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a certain 20' Roadway shall revert to and vest in the owners of the bounding and abutting property; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no compensation be paid to any person by reason of this action by said Board of Supervisors. The said Roadway which is hereby abandoned is described as follows, with reference to its beginning, terminus and general course of direction:

All that portion of a certain roadway described as 20' roadway contiguous to Tract 9, Tract 10 and Tract 11, Back O' Beyond Subdivision, according to the plat thereof recorded November 5, 1951, in Book 5 of Maps and Plats, page 29, Records of Yavapai County, Arizona. Said 20' roadway begins at the northerly boundary of Courta Road, and runs thence northerly and terminates in a dead end at Tract 10, Back O' Beyond Subdivision as shown on said plat.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record of this resolution, together with a map of said roadway, be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, said county being the county wherein said roadway is located.
