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RESOLUTION NO. 6

WHEREAS, Montezuma Well, a National Monument, is one of the scenic wonders of Arizona and is visited by 32,000 people each year.

WHEREAS, the Black Canyon Highway No. 79 passes within a short distance of this National Monument.

WHEREAS, there is an unimproved road beginning at the McGuireville interchange and extending easterly to Montezuma Well and on to the interchange at State Highway No. 179, a distance of five miles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors that the Arizona Highway Department be requested to establish this road between the two interchanges as a State road and appropriate funds for its construction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be mailed to the Arizona Highway Commission for its consideration.
