WHEREAS, Social Security benefits have been initiated and
inaugurated by the Federal Government and,

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors has seen fit
to make the necessary employers' contribution enabling Yavapai County
employees to have full use and advantage of the Social Security program
and,

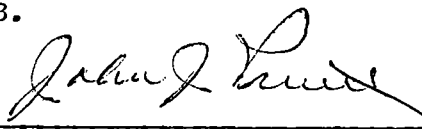
WHEREAS, the Arizona State Retirement System has been established
and the benefits therefrom made available to the employees of Yavapai
County, and,

WHEREAS, Yavapai County has entered into an agreement with the
Arizona State Retirement System and provided the necessary funds to
enable Yavapai County employees to participate in this program and,

WHEREAS, the general efficiency and discharge of the county
responsibilities through its employees would be materially increased,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Yavapai County Board of
Supervisors that all Yavapai County employees be retired upon reaching
the age of sixty-five years to enable them to take full advantage of the
retirement programs provided for them.
