

CITY/COUNTY JOINT SESSIONS  
April 3, 1967

approving a request from the Congress Water Company, Inc., for a six months extension of time in which to comply with Paragraph II of their water franchise.

There was a motion by Supervisor Pruitt, seconded by Supervisor Owens, and unanimously carried approving the boundaries for the coming year of the school districts in Yavapai County as submitted by Warner B. Dixon, Sr., County School Superintendent.

Mr. Victor Trost met with the Board regarding his leasehold interest and improvements at the Oak Creek Airport which the Board had agreed to purchase at an appraised amount. After discussion, an agreement was reached whereby Mr. Trost would continue to operate the airport through April 30, 1967.

There was a motion by Supervisor Owens, seconded by Supervisor Pruitt, and unanimously carried approving an original application for a No. 16 Liquor License by Albert J. Kramer at Lake Montezuma Golf and Country Club.

There was a motion by Supervisor Owens, seconded by Supervisor Pruitt and unanimously carried, to reappoint W. Waits Smith, W. K. Roberts, G. F. Dressel, Ray Steele, Col. Lewis L. Miller and C. L. Hale, to the Sedona Airport Advisory Committee for a one-year term beginning April 1, 1967.

There was a motion by Supervisor Pruitt, seconded by Supervisor Owens, and unanimously carried to adopt a resolution providing for at least one joint session every two months by the Mayor and City Councilmen of the City of Prescott, and the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, and to assume jointly the function of a regional policy agency.

The reports of the various departments were read, approved and ordered filed.

Permission to be out of the State was unanimously granted to M. E. Rohrer, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, April 8, 1967 through April 16, 1967.

The Chairman reported approval of the following Notary Bonds: Doris M. Bowen, Betty Jo Wood, D. M. Meisinger, Shirley Jones, Rose Mary Druse and V. L. Callaway.


There was a motion by Supervisor Pruitt, seconded by Supervisor Owens, and unanimously carried approving the appointment by G. A. Ayars, the County Sheriff, of Merrill Dennis Hoaglund, as Deputy Sheriff.

There was a motion by Supervisor Owens, seconded by Supervisor Pruitt, and unanimously carried approving the recommendation of County Assessor, Joel H. Baldwin, to make the following strikes in the 1966 Real Estate Rolls: #13273; and to make the following strikes in the Personal Property Rolls: 1965, #2225; 1966, #1850; 1967, #2.

No further business appearing to come before the Board, upon motion, the same adjourned in regular order.
