

RESOLUTION NO. 108-A

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR A STUDY TO BE MADE, SETTING FORTH THE NEEDS FOR WATER AND SEWER DEVELOPMENT IN A PORTION OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of Yavapai, State of Arizona, have conducted a comprehensive Planning Study with respect to water and sewer needs over the Southern portion of Yavapai County as described in Resolution No. 91 dated June 20, 1966.

WHEREAS, it is determined that similar studies need to be conducted with the assistance of a competent planner over the remainder of the County of jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the public health and welfare of the affected area is the responsibility of the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Planning and Zoning Commission has agreed to give all the assistance at their command for this project, and

WHEREAS, Yavapai County does not have sufficient funds with which to prepare this study,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to provide for a study to be made, setting forth the needs with respect to water and sewer development for said balance of Yavapai County of jurisdiction. Said study to be accepted at the option of the Board of Supervisors, but to be completed in not more than five (5) years from the date of this Resolution, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County make application to the Farmers Home Administration for a direct grant of funds with which to aid in accomplishing the project outlined, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors are hereby authorized to prepare and sign any and all applications and agreements necessary to further this project, and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors is specifically authorized to execute on behalf of Yavapai County, a nondiscrimination agreement, F. H. A. Form 400-4, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be made a part of the application to the Farmers Home Administration for a direct grant for financial assistance in this project.
