

RESOLUTION NO. 114

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County has appointed a Planning and Zoning Commission for said County, which Commission is presently engaged in obtaining zoning for the unincorporated areas of Yavapai County; and,

WHEREAS, it has become increasingly evident of the need to promote an orderly development and zoning of Yavapai County in those areas surrounding incorporated cities and towns situate in Yavapai County; and,

WHEREAS, various incorporated cities and towns within Yavapai County have evidenced a willingness to cooperate with the County of Yavapai to insure the orderly development of the areas surrounding incorporated cities and towns;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of Yavapai County is hereby authorized to appoint three members to be chosen from the existing Yavapai County Planning and Zoning Commission to meet with any corresponding committee appointed by any incorporated city or town within Yavapai County, to formulate plans and discussions for the orderly development of planning and zoning in the unincorporated areas lying within five (5) miles of any incorporated city or town in Yavapai County, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any actions taken by said three member committee in connection with any corresponding committees of any city or town shall be subject to the approval of the Yavapai County Planning and Zoning Commission and the Board

of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona.
