RESOLUTION NO. 119
ESTABLISHING A COUNTY
HIGHWAY

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on the 6th day of November, 1967, pursuant to legal notice thereof and the Board having fully considered all matters in relation to the feasibility, advantage and necessity of the highway sought to be established and it appearing to the Board of Supervisors that the designating and establishing of the county highway as is herein described and is set forth in said petition as a county highway is a public necessity and that said petition for the establishment of said county highway should be granted and that said petition should be approved and that the Board by resolution shall approve the establishment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the petition for the designating and establishing of a county road as hereinafter described be granted and that said road as hereinafter described be designated and established forthwith as a county road and that this resolution be recorded in the minutes of this Board as of this date.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that all property, easements, and interests therein as described and set forth in said petition or which may be necessary for the purpose of the completion of said highway be, and the same is hereby, condemned and appropriated to public use.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the legal description for the county road is hereby designated and established and is described as follows:

Beginning at a point in Section 33, Township 14 North, Range 2 East, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Yavapai County, Arizona, on the northerly right of way line of the Dewey to Highway 79 (Zane Grey Highway) as established by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors as a county highway, and thence running in a northeasterly direction through Sections 33, 34 and 35, Township 14 North, Range 2 East and through Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4, Township 13 North, Range 2 East and Sections 31, 30, 19, 20, 21, 17 and 16, Township 14 North, Range 3 East and on or near the existing road center line to a point which lies just about in the center of the St. Louis patented mining claim and end of this description.

The exact boundaries, course and distance on both sides of said road being more particularly described on map thereof in the office of the County Engineer of Yavapai County, Arizona, a duplicate copy of which shall be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, reference to said maps being hereby made for a more particular description.
