RESOLUTION NO. 129 OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of June, 1966, the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY duly accepted and approved a realignment of a road known as "PASEO DEL ORO", situate across a portion of Tract B of Cañon del Oro Plat 2; and,

WHEREAS, said resolution of said date by said Board of Supervisors erroneously stated that the title to the land adjacent to said realignment should revert to adjoining land owners; and,

WHEREAS, said error was the result of mistake, inadvertance or clerical error and does not, in fact, reflect the true ownership of said land lying adjacent to said road known as "Paseo del Oro", as realigned;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, as follows:

I

That the certain resolution of the Board of Supervisors dated the 6th day of June, 1966, dealing with the realignment of Paseo del Oro situate across portions of Tract B of Cañon del Oro, Plat 2, and recorded in Book 12 of Maps at page 84, Records of the Yavapai County Recorder, Yavapai County, Arizona, insofar as the same deals with reversion of title adjacent to said realigned road is hereby declared void and of no effect.

II

That the land formally being in the right of way of a road known as Paseo del Oro, and which was abandoned by the resolution above referred to, is hereby declared to revert to and fee title therein is affirmed in, MILTON W. ROBBINS and MURIEL

D. ROBBINS, owners of Tract B of Canon del Oro, Plat 2, a subdivision of Yavapai County, Arizona, according to the plat or map thereof of record in the Yavapai County Recorder's Office, Yavapai County, Arizona.

III

That in all other respects, the abandonment and rededication of a part of a road known as Paseo del Oro, according to the map thereof of record in the Office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Yavapai County, Arizona, is hereby affirmed.
