

RESOLUTION NO. 144

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS ACTING THROUGH THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA DIVISION OF ECONOMIC AND BUSINESS RESEARCH FOR AN URBAN PLANNING ASSISTANCE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the County of Yavapai desires to undertake a comprehensive planning program to guide the orderly future growth and development of the County of Yavapai, preserve community values, prevent development of slums and conditions tending to cause blight, and to promote the general health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is advised that planning grants under authority of Section 314 of the Housing Act of 1954, as amended (42 USC and 1452A), or other sufficient authority, are available to the Arizona Board of Regents acting through the University of Arizona Division of Economic and Business Research to assist local governments in comprehensive planning;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That the County of Yavapai hereby applies for an urban planning assistance project covering technical services generally as described in the attached document entitled Joint Work Program for Prescott - Yavapai County; and,
- (2) That upon approval of such assistance by appropriate State and Federal authorities, said Division of Economic and Business Research is requested to prepare an agreement between the local government and the Arizona Board of Regents; and
- (3) In the event of execution of said agreement and in accordance with the terms thereof, the Yavapai County Treasurer of the County of Yavapai will be authorized and directed to issue to the University of Arizona a warrant or warrants in an aggregate amount not exceeding one-third (1/3) of the total work program cost.
