

RESOLUTION NO. 148

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA.

WHEREAS, The County is the owner of certain lands known as the Oak Creek Canyon Airport located in Yavapai County, State of Arizona, acquired from the United States Government under Section 16 of the Federal Airport Act (49 U.S.C. 1115); and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County have deemed it to be in the public interest to extend the runway servicing said airport; and,

WHEREAS, in order to extend the existing runway to serve the public interests, it is necessary to acquire additional lands belonging to the United States Government; and,

WHEREAS, said lands can be acquired under said Section 16 of the Federal Airport Act for the improving and developing of an existing public airport,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

I

The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, hereby authorizes Marvin E. Rohrer, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, to file a request with the District Airport Engineer of the Federal Aviation Authority for acquisition, under Section 16 of the Federal Airport Act, of the real property hereinafter described.

II

The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, hereby evidence a willingness to accept any conveyance of the real property hereinafter described subject to the covenants and reverter clauses described in section 153.13 of the Federal Aviation Regulations.

III

The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, further

indicate that the County of Yavapai, is willing to accept the property hereinafter described, subject to any other terms that may be imposed by the United States, and subject to any changes in the boundaries or acreage that might be acceptable to the Administrator of the Federal-Aid Airport Program, so far as they concern the development or use of the property for public airport purposes.

IV

That the property required in order to cover the runway extension at the Oak Creek Canyon Airport and to comply with necessary clear zone areas is for full protection of the primary surface and building restriction line and is described as follows:

PARCEL I
