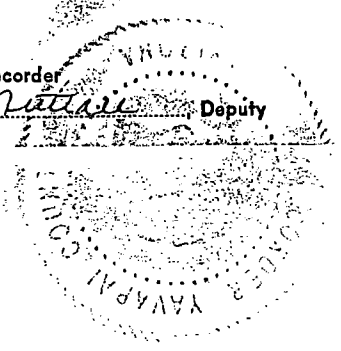

RESOLUTION NO. 159

A RESOLUTION TO ABANDON A ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT TO PIERCE FARMS, INC.

WHEREAS, the Pierce Farms, Inc. did grant to Yavapai County an easement for highway purposes, more particularly described as follows:

The portion of the old right-of-way to be abandoned is that part of the original right-of-way as recorded in Book 4, Page 24 of Maps and Plats in the Office of the Yavapai County Recorder and in Book 11, Page 47 of Maps and Plats in the Office of the Yavapai County Recorder, in Section 18 and 7, T16N, R3W, that conflicts with the new right-of-way map of record in the Yavapai County Recorder's Office in Book 13, Page 96 of Maps and Plats.

WHEREAS, the above section of road easement is not presently required for road purposes by Yavapai County,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, that the above described easement be hereby abandoned and said property does hereby revert to the Pierce Farms, Inc., the grantor of the easement.
