

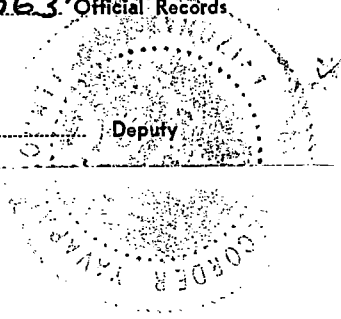

RESOLUTION NO. 161

THIS IS A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA.

WHEREAS, There is presently being operated an airport near Camp Verde, Arizona, by the Camp Verde Business Men's Association under a Special Use Permit from the United States Forest Service; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County have deemed it to be in the public interest to own and operate said Airport; and,

WHEREAS, in order for the County of Yavapai to own and operate said Airport, it is necessary to acquire said land from the United States Government under Section 16 of the Federal Airport Act (49 U.S.C. 1115);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

I

The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, hereby authorizes MARVIN E. ROHRER, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, to file a request with the District Airport Engineer of the Federal Aviation Authority for acquisition, under Section 16 of the Federal Airport Act, of the real property hereinafter described.

II

The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, hereby evidences a willingness to accept any conveyance of the real property hereinafter described subject to the covenants and reverter clauses described in Section 153.13 of the Federal Aviation Regulations.

III

The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, further indicates that the County of Yavapai, is willing to accept the property hereinafter described, subject to any other terms that may be imposed by the United States, or its authorized agencies, and subject to any changes in the boundaries of acreage that might be acceptable to the Administrator of the Federal-Air Airport Program, so far as they concern the development or use of the property for public airport purposes.

IV

That the property necessary to acquire the existing Camp Verde Airport and to comply with necessary clear zone areas is described as follows:
