

RESOLUTION NO. 166

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF ARIZONA, ACTING THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT FOR COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, Yavapai County desires to undertake a comprehensive planning program to guide the orderly future growth and development of the community, preserve community values, prevent conditions tending to cause blight, and to promote the general health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the community lacks adequate resources to undertake such a program; and

WHEREAS, planning grants under authority of Section 701 of Housing Act of 1954, as amended, are available to the State of Arizona, acting through the Department of Economic Planning and Development, to assist local governments in comprehensive planning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, hereby applies for comprehensive planning assistance covering technical services generally as described in the attached document entitled Joint Work Program for Prescott and Yavapai County and dated March 10, 1969: and
- (2) That upon approval of such assistance by appropriate State and Federal authorities, said Department of Economic Planning And Development is requested to prepare an agreement between the government and the State of Arizona; and
- (3) That upon approval by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County and execution of said agreement and in accordance with the terms thereof, the Board of Supervisors is authorized and directed to issue to

the Department of Economic Planning and Development a check or checks in an approximate amount of \$6,050.00.
