

RESOLUTION No. 175

OF

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF
YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, we consider the orderly development of Poverty Programs in the five Northern counties (NADEC) to be a matter of local concern as well as regional concern in terms of serving the long-term development needs of our people, and

WHEREAS, recent Federal legislation provides the means whereby these ends may be accomplished, and

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for cooperative endeavor in developing comprehensive and regional poverty programs suitable to local needs and capability.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:


The Board of Supervisors, Yavapai County, State of Arizona, do hereby agree in principal that the Northern Arizona Development Council be designated as the Multi-county Community Action Agency for Poverty Programs (OEO) developed within Yavapai County, and that a public hearing shall be held on or about November 17, 1969.
