

RESOLUTION NO. 169

RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE NADEC THE MULTI-COUNTY COMMUNITY ACTION
AGENCY TO ADMINISTER OEO PROGRAMS IN YAVAPAI COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, realizing the need to stimulate a better focusing of all available local, State, Federal, and private resources to enable programs directed toward fighting the War on Poverty, help low income families and individuals in the community, and secure opportunities needed for them to become fully self-sufficient, and

In accordance with Public Law 90-222, known as the Economic Opportunity Act Amendments of 1967, the Board of Supervisors, by the powers vested in them by the State of Arizona, desire to make maximum use of Federal Funds and all resources available within these counties and the state, and to more effectively and economically implement Community Action Programs in the War on Poverty, and


Since the Northern Arizona Development Council, a Joint Powers Agency, pursuant to the authority of the Arizona Revised Statutes, Sections 11-952, is legally competent to contract with the Office of Economic Opportunity for the administration of Poverty Program Activities which fall within the jurisdiction of that agency.

THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, do hereby designate the Northern Arizona Economic Development Council (NADEC) as the multi-county Community Action Agency to administer the programs of the Office of Economic Opportunity (OEO) within Yavapai County.
