

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors, Yavapai County, State of Arizona, does hereby officially support the opposition taken by the Board of Supervisors, Greenlee County, State of Arizona, on November 3, 1969 in the reclassification of the Blue Range Primitive Area to a Wilderness Area as not in the best interest of the citizens of the United States of America, the State of Arizona, or the County of Greenlee, Arizona.
