WHEREAS, said application came on regularly for hearing at the aforesaid time and place and no petition having been filed by qualified electors of the County petitioning the Board of Supervisors to deny such privilege, and it appearing to be best for public safety and welfare to impose restrictions and limitations,

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, does hereby grant unto SHAMROCK WATER COMPANY, an Arizona Corporation and its successors and assigns, if assignment be permitted, subject to the terms, conditions and limitations hereinafter contained, the right, privilege, license and franchise to construct, maintain and operate water lines, pipe lines, and mains, for a period of twenty-five (25) years from the date hereof, for the transmission and delivery of water for domestic use along, upon, under and across the public highways, roads, thoroughfares, alleys and public ways (excepting State Highways) within the following described portion of Yavapai County, Arizona:

PARCEL 1:

All that portion of Section 21, Township 14 North, Range 1 West, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the section corner common to Sections 16, 17. 20 and 21, above Township and Range, thence North 89°56' East for 3983.63 feet to an iron pin and TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of this description thence South 0°05' East for 2637.86 feet to an iron pin and Southwest corner of this parcel: Thence East for 676.14 feet to an iron pin thence South 0°10'10" East for 148.26 feet to an iron pin

on the Northerly right of way line of U. S. Highway 69; thence Easterly along the right of way line of U. S. Highway 69 for 746.12 feet to the S.C. STA. 4672 plus 05.00; thence Easterly along a curve on the right of way line for 6.94 feet to an iron pin and Southeast Corner of this parcel; thence North 0°10'10" West for 2,477.72 feet to an iron pin and Northeast corner of this parcel; Thence South 89°56' West for 1,357.11 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

EXCEPT and portion thereof within MOUNTAIN SHADOWS SUBDIVISION #1, according to the plat of record in the office of the Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, in Book 7 of Maps, page 36.

ALSO EXCEPT any portion thereof lying within the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 22, Township 14 North, Range 1 West, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian.

PARCEL 2:

Lots 1 through 19, MOUNTAIN SHADOWS SUBDIVISION # 1, according to the plat of record in the office of the Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, in Book 7 of Maps, page 36.

A public service franchise was originally granted to SHAMROCK WATER COMPANY by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on March 22, 1965, and thereafter various extensions of the public service franchise area have been granted by the Board of Supervisors. This franchise shall constitute a further extension of the public service franchise area of Grantee.

RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

1. All rights and privileges hereunder are granted under the express condition that the Board of Supervisors shall have the power at any time to impose such additional and further restrictions and limitations and to make such regulations on such highways, roads, thoroughfares, alleys, and public ways as may be deemed best for the public safety, welfare and

convenience.

- 2. All rights and privileges hereunder shall be exercised so as to not interfere or conflict with any easements or rights-of-way heretofore granted by said Board of Supervisors and now in force.
- 3. All rights and privileges hereunder shall be exercised so as not to interfere or conflict with any easement, either public or private, of whatsoever nature, which has been acquired in or to the proper use of said highways, roads, thoroughfares, alleys, and public ways, or any portion thereof.
- 4. All rights and privileges hereunder shall be exercised so as not to interfere or conflict with or endanger in any way the proper use by the public of said highways, roads, thoroughfares, alleys, and public ways or any portion thereof.
- 5. Grantee shall bear all expenses, including damages and compensation to any legally aggrieved third parties, incurred or expended for the alteration of the course, direction, surface, grade or alignment of any of the said highways, roads, thoroughfares, alleys, and public ways necessarily made by or for Grantee for the purpose of exercising any right under this franchise, and Grantee shall maintain its water lines, pipe lines and mains at its own cost and expense and will make all necessary repairs from time to time as the same may be needed without the necessity of notice from Yavapai County, but in the event Grantee shall fail to make any repairs within thirty days from the time same become necessary, Yavapai County may cause the same to be made and Grantee shall pay Yavapai County the cost or reasonable value thereof, but if in the sole judgment

of the County, emergency repairs become necessary the County may accomplish or contract for same without notice or delay, and Grantee shall pay Yavapai County the cost or reasonable value thereof.

- All water mains and other portions of the distributing system to be installed and operated by Grantee shall be placed in such manner and location as the Board of Supervisors or its duly authorized agents may designate.
- 7. Grantee shall indemnify Yavapai County and save it harmless from all costs, expenses and liabilities in connection with the granting of this franchise and exercise of the same by Grantee.
- The rights of any person claiming to be injured or damaged in any manner by Grantee or by the exercise of any right or privilege hereunder shall not be affected hereby.
- This franchise shall not be deemed to be exclusive and the Board of Supervisors hereby expressly reserves the right and power from time to time to grant similar franchises and privileges over the same territory and highways, roads, thoroughfares, alleys, and public ways.
- 10. This franchise is granted upon the express condition subsequent that a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity be procured from the Arizona Corporation Commission within six months from the date of granting of this franchise; and if such Certificate is not granted within six months from said date, then this franchise to be void, otherwise to be in full force and effect for the time herein specified.
