RESOLUTION NO. 248

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County road commonly known as the Date Creek Road, between Hillside and Highway 89 is heavily used by the residents of the area, and WHEREAS, the number of residents of the area has increased over a period of time, and

WHEREAS, the present condition of the road is dirt construction with no suitable crossings over the various, many, and deep water courses, and

WHEREAS, Yavapai County is without sufficient funds to suitably improve this road to handle the increased need,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors that the State Highway Department be requested to make the connecting road between Hillside and Highway 89 a State Federal Aid Secondary Route so that Federal funds may be obtained for its construction;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be mailed to the Arizona State Highway Commission for its consideration.
