A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURN AND DECLARING
THE RESULT OF ELECTION FOR TRUSTEES AND DIRECTING
ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF ELECTION FOR
SPECIAL ROAD DISTRICT NO. 1 OF YAVAPAI COUNTY
(LAKE MONTEZUMA) ARIZONA
