

RESOLUTION NO. 296

A RESOLUTION FIXING AMOUNT AND APPROVING BOND,
FIXING TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING, AND
DIRECTING NOTICE.

REZZONICO ESTATES IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the
County of Yavapai, Arizona, that

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the
Clerk of this Board, addressed to this Board, requesting a
hearing on and the establishment of a county improvement district
to be known as Rezzonico Estates Improvement District;

WHEREAS, said petition shows that it is signed
by a majority of the persons owing real property or by the
owners of fifty-one per cent (51%) or more of the real property
within the limits of the district proposed by said petition to
be formed, and is verified by one of the signers thereof; and

WHEREAS, said petition is accompanied by a cash
bond in the amount of \$100.00 payable to this County, to pay
the expenses connected with the proceeding in case the Board
refuses to establish the district;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FOUND, DETERMINED AND
ORDERED, as follows:

1. Said petition conforms to the requirements
of Article 1, Chapter 5, Title 11 of Arizona Revised Statutes,
and is sufficient.
2. The amount of the bond is sufficient and is
approved.
3. Monday, the 5th day of August, 1974 at the
hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., in the Supervisors Chambers,
Courthouse, Prescott, Arizona are fixed as the time and place
of hearing said petition, at which time all interested
property owners may appear and be heard on any matter relating
to the establishment of the proposed improvement district.
4. Notice announcing the hearing and stating the
boundaries of the proposed district shall be posted within
the proposed district for not less than ten (10) days prior
to the date of hearing, as provided by law.

5. A copy of said notice shall be published twice in the Prescott Courier, a newspaper published in the County and of general circulation within the proposed district, one week apart, the first of which shall not be less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing.
