

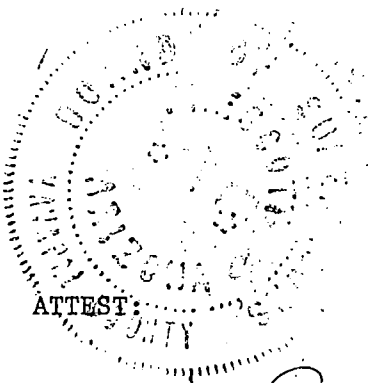

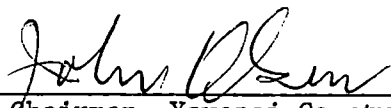
A RESOLUTION PRESCRIBING FEES FOR LICENSING OF DOGS.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. 24-367 requires the setting of license fees for licensing of dogs, the following fee structure and procedure shall be followed:

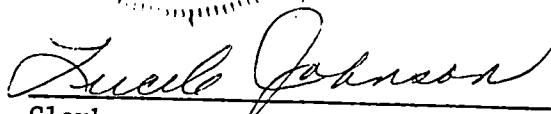
1. The Sheriff shall maintain records of all dog licenses issued and shall issue licenses and tags upon payment of the \$3.00 fee and presentation of a certificate of vaccination.
2. The Sheriff may designate dog licensing centers at which licenses may also be obtained. These centers will remit to the Sheriff the \$3.00 fee for each license and tag issued. Each such designated center may charge the public no more than \$4.00 for each license and tag issued.
3. This resolution shall supplement and provide implementation for the provisions of A.R.S. 24-367 and is in no way designed to substitute for or supersede the provisions of that statute.
