

RESOLUTION NO. 321

BEFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
YAVAPAI COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA

A Resolution urging that Forest Road # 9 leading from Camp Verde to the Long Valley Road be designated the "General George Crook Trail".

WHEREAS, General George Crook, Military Commander of the Arizona Territory following the Civil War, commenced construction of said trail in 1873, and

WHEREAS, General George Crook was instrumental in establishing a trail from Camp Verde to the Long Valley Road during that period of time for military tactical purposes, and

WHEREAS, Forest Road # 9 follows generally the trail established by General George Crook from Camp Verde to the Long Valley Road, and

WHEREAS, the County of Yavapai desires General George Crook be historically recognized for his achievement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Road described in the above recitals be designated, by the persons responsible for such action, as the "General George Crook Trail".
