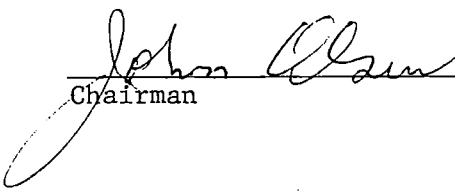
A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO ELECT
THAT THE COUNTY ATTORNEY SHALL BE A FULL-TIME OFFICER.

WHEREAS, Yavapai County has been designated as a County
of the first class with a combined census and registered voter
total of less than two hundred thousand as determined by the
latest federal census and the total number of voters in the county
registered for the general election as required by ARS 11-419-B,
and

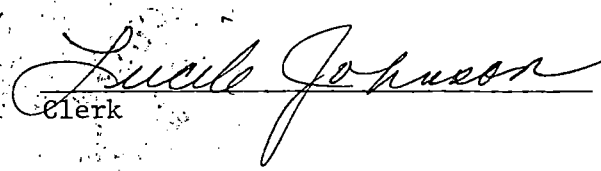
WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors believe
that the citizens of Yavapai County can best be served by the Office
of the County Attorney being filled by an attorney who devotes his
full time to that office and does not engage in private practice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the office of the
County Attorney of Yavapai County shall be filled by an attorney
who shall not engage in the private practice of law, but shall
be subject to the provisions of ARS 11-419 E.
