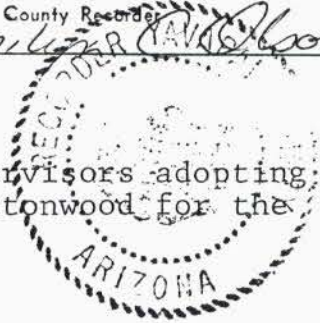

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RESOLUTION NO. 373

A resolution of the Board of Supervisors adopting an agreement with the Town of Cottonwood for the reconstruction of a bridge.



WHEREAS, the TOWN OF COTTONWOOD and YAVAPAI COUNTY jointly own and desire to reconstruct a bridge over an irrigation district at the end of 16th Street in Cottonwood, which bridge is partly in the TOWN and partly in the COUNTY and to divide the cost thereof between the COUNTY and the TOWN.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The attached agreement between the TOWN OF COTTONWOOD and YAVAPAI COUNTY is hereby approved.

2. The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors is authorized and directed to sign the agreement on behalf of YAVAPAI COUNTY.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made and entered into on this 14 day of November, 1977, by and between YAVAPAI COUNTY, a subdivision of the State of Arizona, hereinafter designated as COUNTY, and the TOWN OF COTTONWOOD, a municipal corporation of the State of Arizona, hereinafter designated as TOWN.

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS the bridge over an irrigation ditch on Sixteenth (16th) Street is now in bad condition and needs to be rebuilt; and such bridge is partly in the COUNTY and partly in the TOWN; and

WHEREAS the COUNTY and TOWN desire to rebuild such bridge as a cooperative project, sharing the expenses thereof

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED by and between the COUNTY and the TOWN:

1. That the bridge on Sixteenth (16th) Street Street as shown on the attached plat shall be reconstructed by the COUNTY of new pressure-treated Douglas Fir timbers and planks of sizes and quality equal to the prior construction, and as the attached specifications require.
2. That such work shall be completed within 60 calendar days after this Agreement is filed with the Yavapai County Recorder.
3. The TOWN will pay one-half of the direct costs of such bridge replacement, but not to exceed \$1,625 thereof as its share of the costs. The COUNTY shall keep and maintain a record of all direct costs of the project, including equipment use, which will be charged at the COUNTY rates as revised in April 1974. No indirect costs of supervision and management shall be charged to the project. The TOWN shall pay its share of the project cost upon completion of the project by the COUNTY and submission by the COUNTY of a statement showing the total cost of the project.
4. The project will be paid for by the COUNTY from its Road Fund and the TOWN from its Highway Use Revenue Funds.
5. This Agreement shall not become effective until both parties have authorized the execution and have executed it, and a copy has been filed with the Yavapai County Recorder.

6. This Agreement shall not relieve either of the parties of any obligations or responsibility imposed upon such party by law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties have caused this Agreement to be executed in triplicate form by their respective officers, being duly authorized to do so.

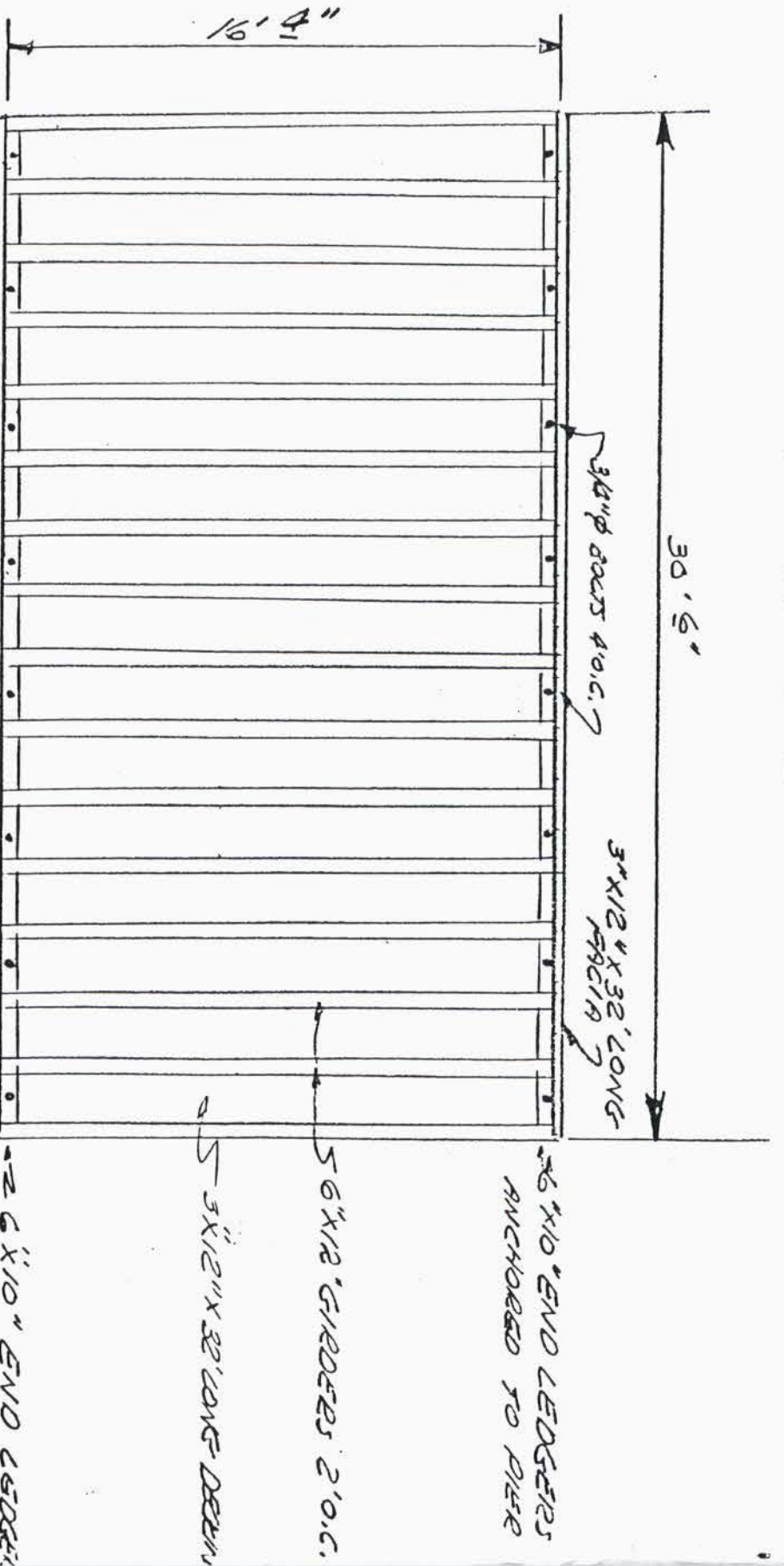
