

RESOLUTION NO. 426

MEDICAL RELIEF AND AID ELIGIBILITY MANUAL REVISION, OBSTETRICAL CARE


BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the following revision to the Manual:


1. All unmarried applicants shall cooperate with the County Attorney's Office in establishing the paternity of the child as a condition of eligibility for obstetrical care.
2. All married applicants who are separated from their spouses and who are otherwise eligible shall cooperate with the County Attorney's Office in locating the absent putative parent so that appropriate proceedings can be instituted to enforce the parent's duty of support.
3. All married applicants who are otherwise eligible shall be considered eligible for county medical assistance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the present written M.R.A. policy, entitled "O.B. CARE", is repealed.
