

Resolution No. 440

PROVIDING FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF THE CAMP VERDE-MONTEZUMA CASTLE HIGHWAY AND McGUIREVILLE-CORNVILLE ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THE CAMP VERDE-MONTEZUMA CASTLE HIGHWAY AND THE McGUIREVILLE-CORNVILLE ROAD.

WHEREAS, road resurfacing work on the Camp Verde-Montezuma Castle Highway and McGuireville-Cornville Road was contracted to Asphalt Products Transport Co., Inc. of Tucson, Arizona, by contract dated September 24, 1979, and such work was not satisfactory in that the surfacing did not adhere, pot holed and buckled, leaving the roads in a dangerous condition for public travel; and

WHEREAS, a settlement has been made with Asphalt Products Transport Co., Inc. and funds withheld from payment of such contract adequate to repair such roads at present costs; and

WHEREAS, temperatures will be too low by October 15 to permit asphalt work to be done and unless such work is immediately undertaken it will have to be deferred until summer of 1981 when the costs will be generally increased; and

WHEREAS, such work can be undertaken immediately by contractors in time to complete the same this fall and such work should be so done,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that an Emergency exists and the bid requirements of A.R.S. §42-306 shall not be applicable to the resurfacing project of said Camp Verde-Montezuma Castle Highway and McGuireville-Cornville Road, and that the County Engineer shall negotiate and submit to the Board an agreement for resurfacing of the said Camp Verde-Montezuma Castle Highway and McGuireville-Cornville Road within the funds available in the Public Works Reserve Fund as the result of such settlement with Asphalt Products Transport Co., Inc.
