

Resolution No. 447

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY ON WINDY POINT SECTION OF SALT MINE ROAD

WHEREAS, the Salt Mine Road is in danger of slipping and endangering the traveling public at Windy Point and a rerouting of such road has been planned and right-of-way for such relocation is being obtained; and

WHEREAS, funds are available and have been budgeted in the Public Works Reserve Fund for the 1980-81 year, and


WHEREAS, litigation has been commenced against Yavapai County regarding such hazardous condition of Salt Mine Road at Windy Point; and


WHEREAS, winter weather will increase the hazard at Windy Point, and can delay the construction of the relocated road; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §42-306(F) provides for expenditure of Public Works Reserve Funds on projects costing more than \$20,000 only by contract after call for bids, unless a resolution declaring an emergency is unanimously declared by the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that an emergency exists on the Windy Point section of the Salt Mine Road of Yavapai County, and that the County Engineer be and hereby is authorized and directed immediately to relocate such portion of Salt Mine Road and to construct a new road as shown on the attached plan, either using County crews and equipment or contracting for all or portions of such relocation work without bid formalities, as will expedite such road work, and that such road work shall be paid from the Public Works Reserve Fund.


