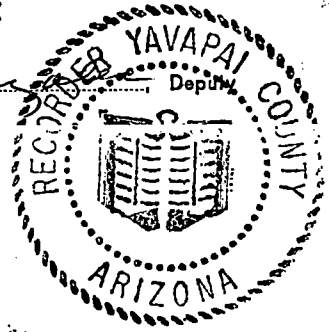

RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

Resolution No. 457

The above matter regularly coming on before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting on March 9, 1981, on the petition of William E. and Mary Jane Martin requesting the abandonment of the herein-after described portion of Wood Street, Camp Verde Townsite, Yavapai County, Arizona, to vest in Parcel 404-23-19, the adjacent property, and the County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment, and it appearing to the Board of Supervisors that the abandonment of such street will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and the same should be granted.

And it further appearing that due and regular notice of the proposed abandonment was duly and regularly given by publications of notice on February 20 and 27, 1981, and proof of such publications has been made and filed with the Board.

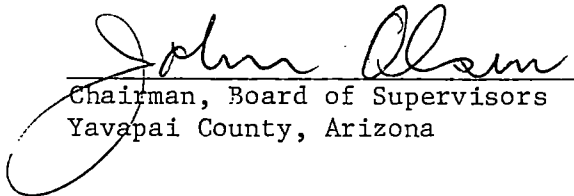

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacated portion of the street shall vest in the adjacent property, Parcel 404-23-19.

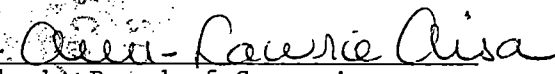
