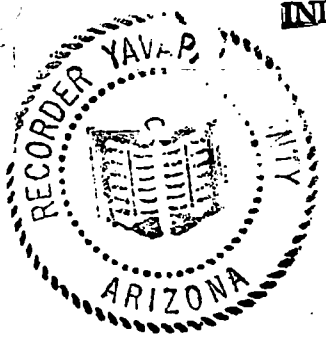

RESOLUTION NO. 465



DESIGNATING AND ESTABLISHING THE VERDE VALLEY SCHOOL ROAD
AS A
YAVAPAI COUNTY ROAD

2nd

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on the 27th day of April, 1981, pursuant to legal notice thereof; on the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors on the 6th day of April, 1981: and, the Board determining that the establishment of Verde Valley School Road as a County road is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantage, and necessity of its establishment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that said Verde Valley School Road as hereinafter described be designated and established forthwith as a County road.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the legal description for the Verde Valley School Road is hereby designated and established as shown on attached Exhibit A and is described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the Verde Valley School Road and the northerly line of the Oak Shadows Subdivision as recorded in Book 14 Page 75 of Maps & Plats in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder; thence running in a northwesterly direction through Sections 10 & 11, T16N, R5E, and Sections 35 & 26, T17N, R5E, to its intersection with the south end of the Red Rock Loop Road, as established by Resolution #24 dated May 7, 1962.

The exact boundaries, course, and distance on both sides of said road being more particularly described on a map thereof in the office of the County Engineer of Yavapai County, Arizona, a duplicate copy of which shall be filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, Arizona, reference to said map being hereby made for a more particular description.

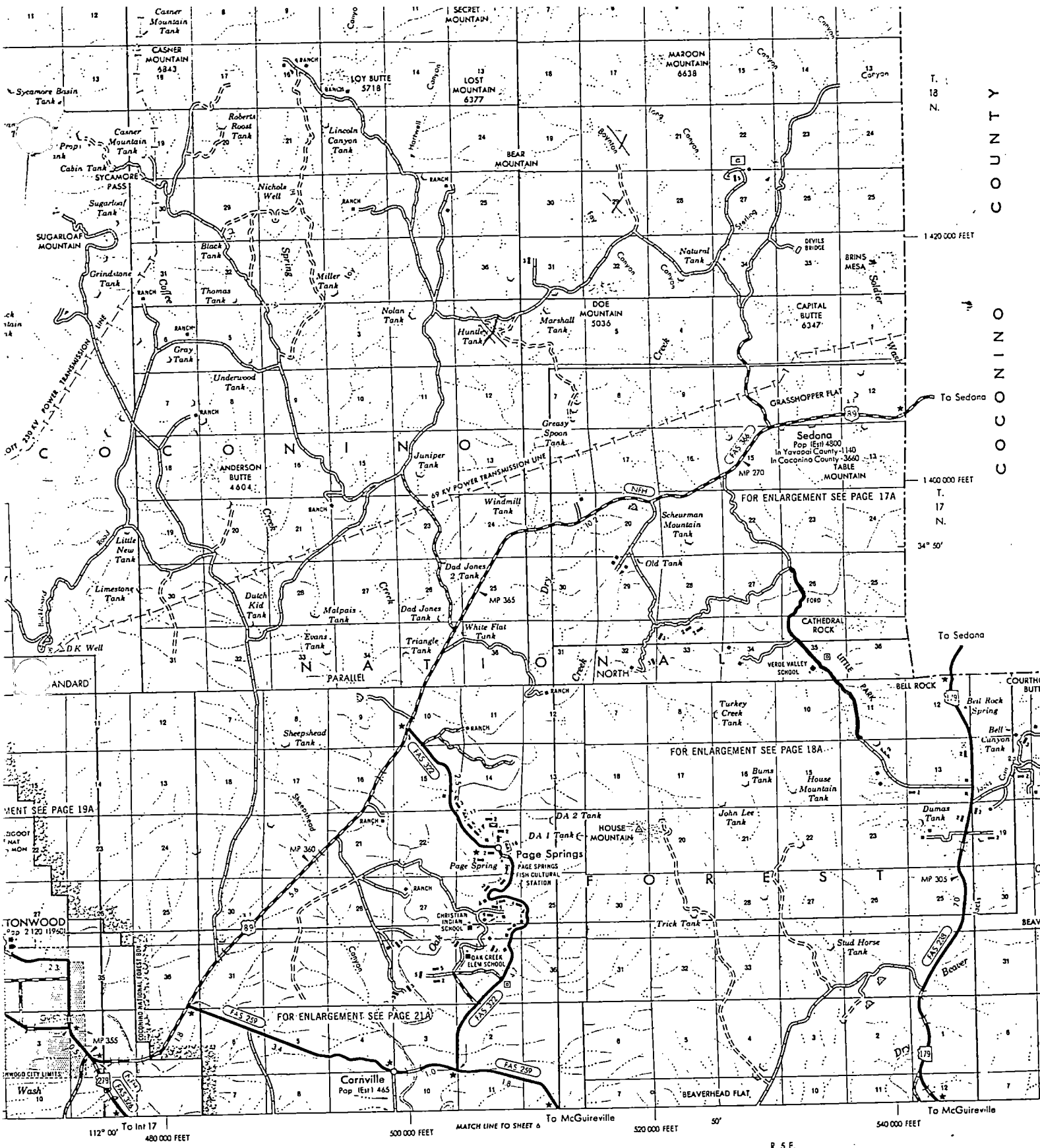
