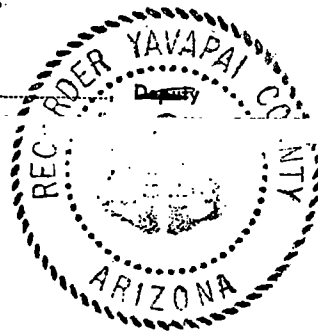

RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

The above matter regularly coming on before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting on November 2, 1981, on the petition of Richard L. White requesting the abandonment of the hereinafter described portion of Onyx Pass, Canyon Sights U-1 and The Prescott Riviera, Yavapai County, Arizona, to vest in Yavapai County Assessor's Parcels; 112-6-50, 112-4-10, 112-4-11, 112-4-79, 112-4-78, 112-4-77, 112-4-76 under A.R.S. §28-1902 (3) (a) (b) (c); and 112-4-99 under A.R.S. §28-1902 (3) (d), the adjacent properties, and the County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment, and it appearing to the Board of Supervisors that the abandonment of such portion of a street will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and the same should be granted.

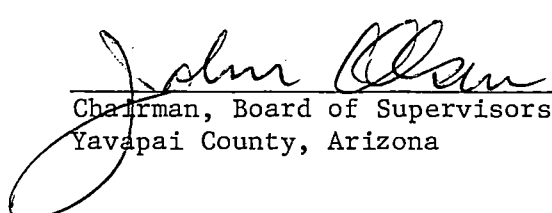
And it further appearing that due and regular notice of the proposed abandonment was duly and regularly given by publications of notice on October 16 and 23, 1981, and proof of such publications has been made and filed with the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the request for abandonment of a portion of Onyx Pass, Canyon Sights Unit One and The Prescott Riviera, subdivisions, Yavapai County, Arizona, as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be and the same hereby is granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacated portion of a street shall vest in the adjacent properties as described by the Yavapai County Assessor's Parcels listed above.

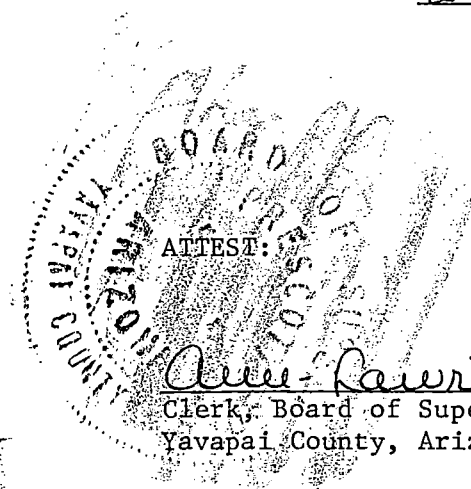
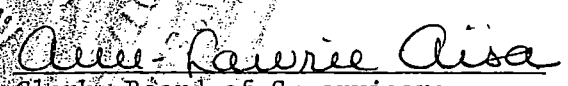
