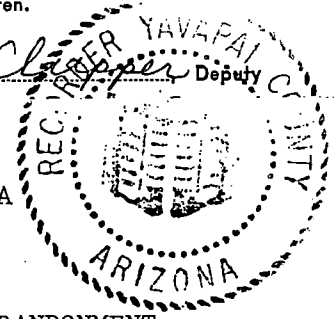

RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

Resolution No. 493

The above matter regularly coming on before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting on November 23, 1981, on the petition of Queen Creek Land and Cattle Company requesting the abandonment of the hereinafter described portion of Paradise Drive, Verde Village Unit 8 and Verde Palisades Plat 2 subdivisions, Yavapai County, Arizona, to vest in Yavapai County Assessor's Parcels 406-50-87 and 406-05-78, the adjacent properties, and the County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment, and it appearing to the Board of Supervisors that the abandonment of such portion of a street will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and the same should be granted.

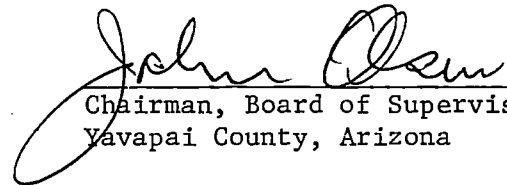
And it further appearing that due and regular notice of the proposed abandonment was duly and regularly given by publications of notice on November 6 and 13, 1981, and proof of such publications has been made and filed with the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the request for abandonment of a portion of Paradise Drive, Verde Village Unit 8 and Verde Palisades Plat 2, Yavapai County, Arizona, from its intersection with Viejo Drive to its intersection with Rancho Vista Way and Peila Avenue, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be and the same hereby is granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacated portion of a street shall vest in the adjacent properties, Yavapai County Assessor's Parcels 406-50-87 and 406-05-78.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded along with an abandonment plat map of the abandoned portion of a street in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.

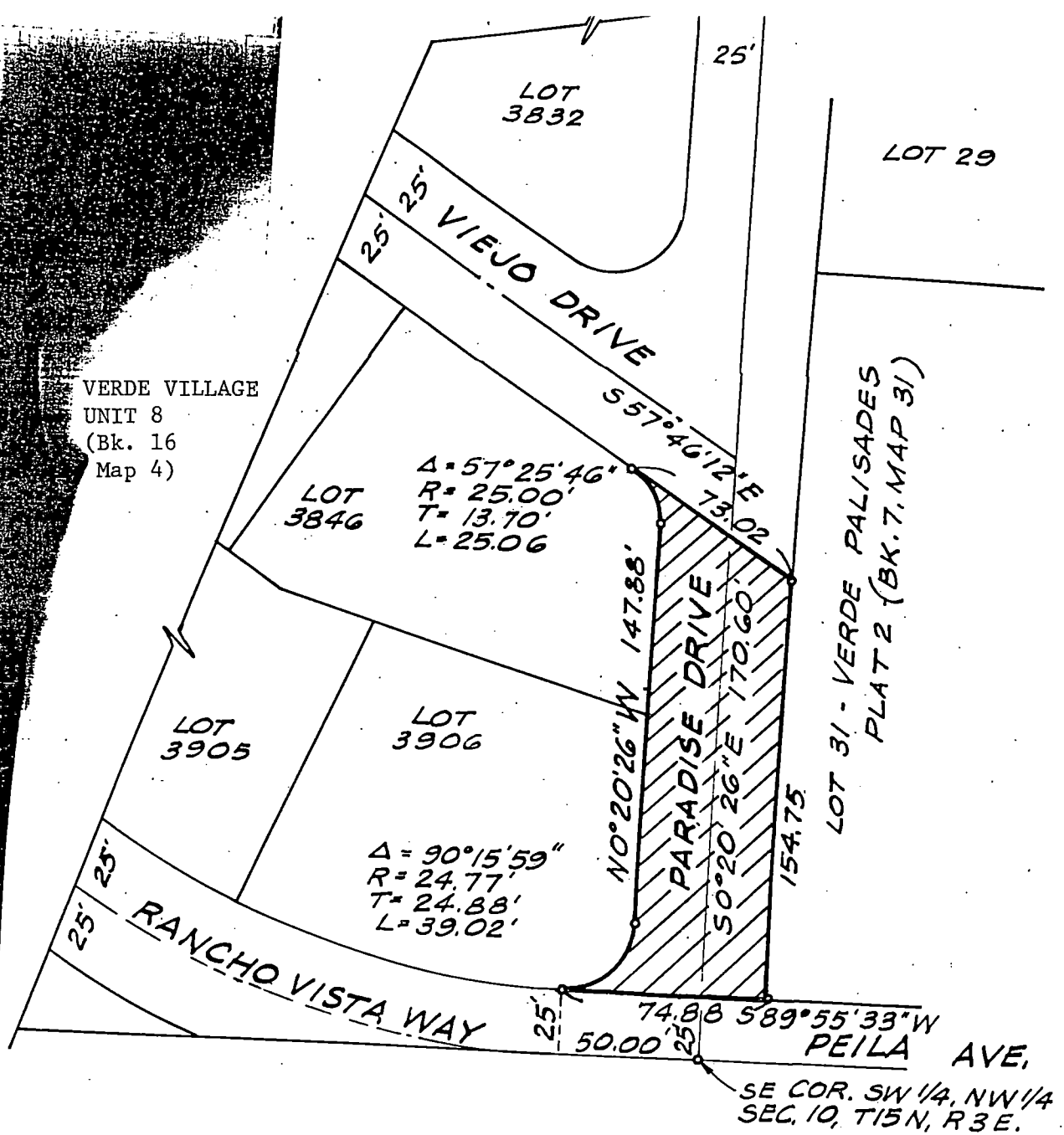

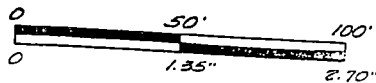
