DISTRIBUTED BY CURRENT FORMULA

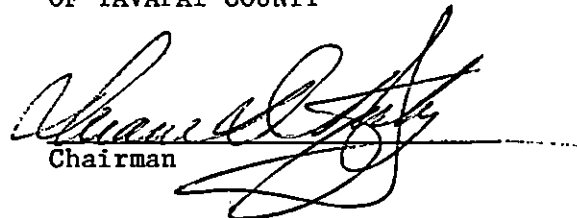

WHEREAS, the Arizona State legislature is considering the addition of 1/2 cent to the State Sales Tax;

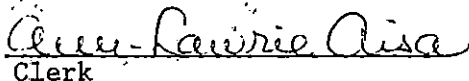

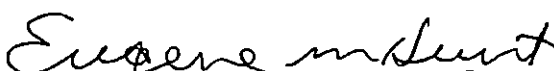

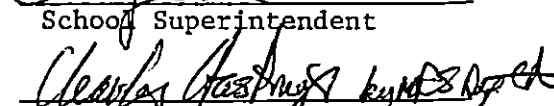
