

RESOLUTION NO. 562

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
COUNTY OF YAVAPAI FINDING, PURSUANT TO
THE REQUIREMENTS OF A.R.S. 36-1473, THAT
A BLIGHTED AREA EXISTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS, the State Community Development Block Grant Program provides assistance for eligible activities which aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight; and

WHEREAS, the State Community Development Block Grant Program requires that an applicant, requesting funds for an activity that will aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight, identify a Target Area where such funds will be expended; and

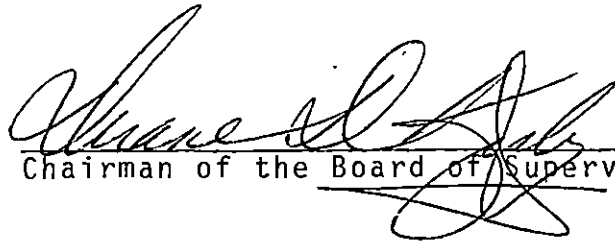
WHEREAS, the County of Yavapai is applying for State Community Development Block Grant funds for an activity that will aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the County of Yavapai finds, pursuant to A.R.S. 36-1473, that the area described as the Camp Verde Sanitary District is the Target Area where State Community Development Block Grant funded activities designed to aid in the prevention and elimination of slum or blight will be carried out; and

THAT, the attached map further identifies the Target Area.

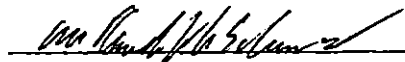
