

RESOLUTION NO. 565

REGARDING THE INCLUSION OF DEPUTY COUNTY ATTORNEYS
IN THE MERIT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Yavapai County has adopted a limited merit system pursuant to A.R.S. §11-351 et seq., and

WHEREAS, deputy county attorneys are presently unclassified, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to classify deputy county attorneys pursuant to the requirements of A.R.S. §11-352.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

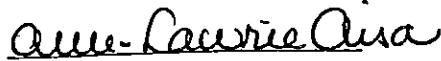
1. Deputy county attorneys are hereby included within the Yavapai County merit system;
2. A chief deputy county attorney appointed pursuant to A.R.S. §11-419(F) shall be removed from the merit system.
3. Salaries for the entire 1983-84 fiscal year shall be as adopted in the 1983-84 budget.
4. Commencing in the 1984-85 fiscal year, salaries shall increase to the next step every six months.
5. Deputy county attorneys shall not receive cost of living or merit increases.
