RESOLUTION NO. 570

AUTHORIZING YAVAPAI COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH OTHER COUNTIES TO DETERMINE AHCCCS ELIGIBILITY FOR COUNTY OF RESIDENCE

- WHEREAS, with the passage of Senate Bill 1279, 36th Legislature, 1983, counties are required in the eligibility determination process to give a priority to persons potentially eligible who are currently receiving care; and
- WHEREAS, section 13 of Senate Bill 1279 the AHCCCS System is rectroactively liable for payment of care which was provided in the period of five days prior to the date that the county determines a person eligible and complies with the notice provision set forth in rules and regulations; and
- WHEREAS, an AHCCCS eligible person could be in transit in any part of the state; and
- WHEREAS, the counties must determine a person AHCCCS eligible that is in the hospital setting receiving emergency care within five days to avoid any potential financial liability for that person;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County authorizes the county to enter into an intergovernmental agreement at no cost to any county to determine eligibility for the county of residence. The administrative flow will be determined by the eligibility office.
