

The above matter regularly coming on before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting on October 3, 1983, on the petition of Mr. and Mrs. Clifford Dillon requesting the abandonment of the hereinafter described portion of Montezuma Haven Subdivision, Yavapai County, Arizona, to vest in the hereinafter described manner, and the County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment, and it appearing to the Board of Supervisors that the abandonment of such portion of a street will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and is no longer necessary for public use, and the same should be granted;

And it further appearing that due and regular notice of the proposed abandonment was duly and regularly given by publications of notice on September 9 and 16, 1983, and proof of such publications has been made and filed with the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the request for abandonment of the west 20 feet of Fishers Way, Montezuma Haven subdivision, as recorded in Book 13 Page 73 of Maps and Plats in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, to vest in the adjacent Yavapai County Assessor's parcel 405-11-151; and the abandonment of

the east 20 feet of Fishers Way in said Montezuma Haven subdivision, to vest in the adjacent Yavapai County Assessor's parcel 405-11-150, and reserving the center 10 feet to Yavapai County, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be and the same hereby is granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this abandonment be contigent upon the establishment of a permanent 10 foot wide easement, as shown on the attached Exhibit B, for ingress and egress to Beaver Creek, through Mr. Clifford Dillon's metes and bounds property, as recorded in Book 1525, Pages 282 - 289 inclusive, and as shown on Exhibit C. Said easement to be maintained by Mr. Clifford Dillon along with the 10 feet of Fishers Way retained by Yavapai County, and with the understanding that Mr. Clifford Dillon would not object to the use by the public of said property all along the creek. Said easement is not intended to provide access into The Sycamores subdivision as recorded in Book 6, Page 63, of Maps and Plats, in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder. Said easement shall be recorded in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded along with an abandonment plat map of the abandoned portion of a street in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.



## EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, CLIFFORD C. DILLON and MILDRED E. DILLON, husband and wife, hereinafter called "Grantors," for and in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00), and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt of said sum being hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant and convey unto YAVAPAI COUNTY, a body politic, hereinafter called "Grantee," an easement for ingress and egress ten (10) feet in width upon, over and across the property of Grantors, more fully described in an instrument recorded in Book 1525 of Official Records, page 282, in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, said easement being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

An easement for ingress and egress 10 feet in width, being five feet on each side of the centerline of Fisher's Way, beginning on the Northern boundary of the property of Grantors as described above, and running as a continuation and extension of said 10-foot easement on Fisher's Way across Grantors' above described property to THE SYCAMORES SUBDIVISION.

It is not intended that this easement shall provide access into THE
