Button requesting the abandonment of the hereinafter described portion of Navajo Road, Hassayampa Mountain Club, Plat F, Yavapai County, Arizona, to vest in the Yavapai County Assessor's parcels 107-14-8D, 107-14-11, 107-1-71, and 107-1-72 the adjacent properties, and the County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment, and it appearing to the Board of Supervisors that the abandonment of such portion of a street will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and is no longer necessary for public use, and the same should be granted.

of Maps and Plats, Yavapai County Recorder's office, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be and the same hereby is granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacated portion of a street shall vest in the adjacent properties Yavapai County Assessor's parcels 107-14-8D, 107-14-11, 107-1-71, and 107-1-72.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded along with an abandonment plat map of the abandoned portion of a street in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.

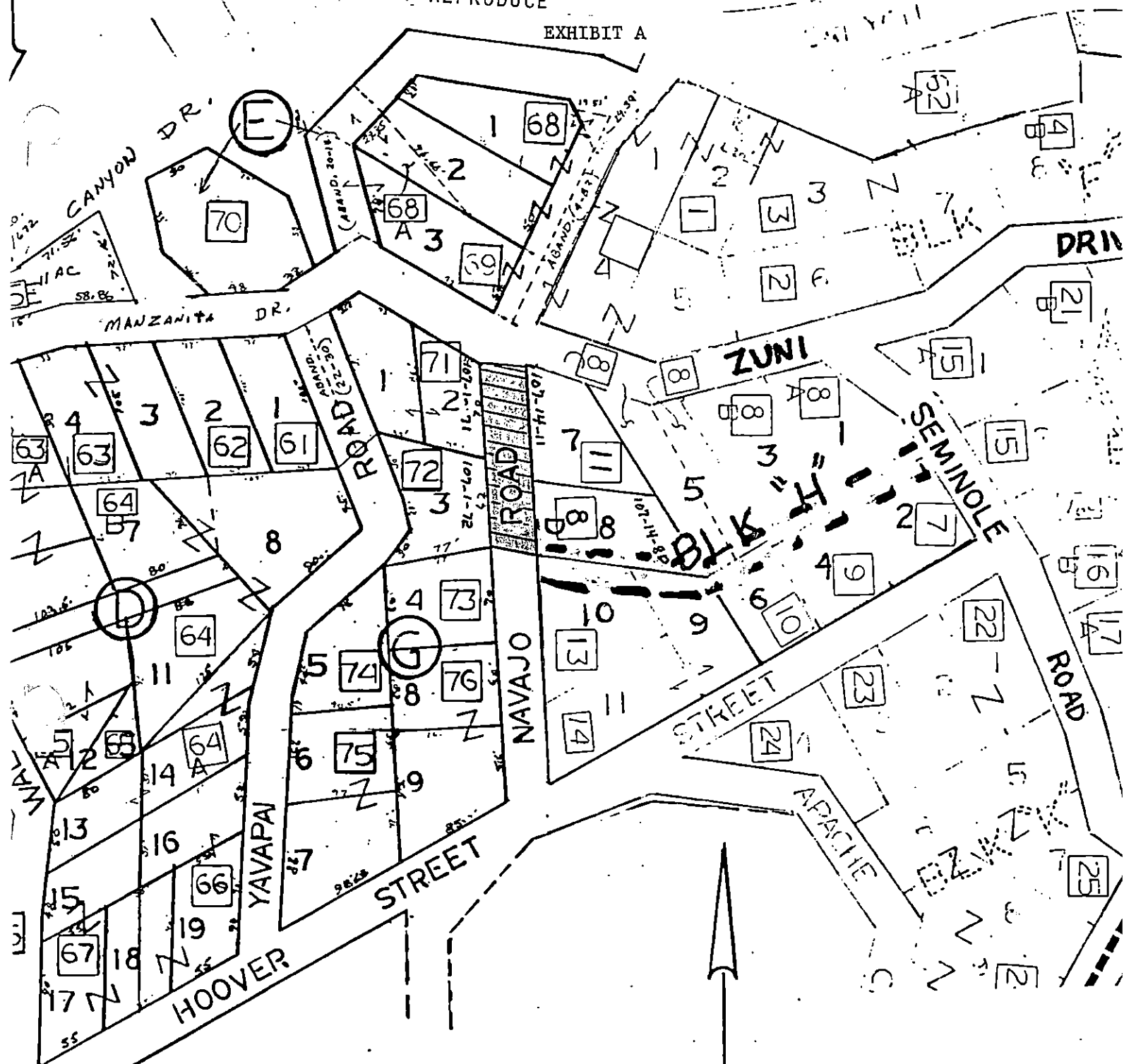
